### ANNUAL REPORT 2007/2008

#### Chairman's Report

The Town Council has now been formed for just over a year and in that time I feel it has achieved a lot.

It initially proved difficult to find an office base that was well-located and accessible for the community but in April 2008 the Council moved into its current premises in the High Street. Employing a Town Clerk was also challenging as it is a specialist job and requires particular expertise. Mrs Julie Abel joined us in January 2008 from another town council in Essex.

In February, the Council organized a tree planting scheme at Tewkes Creek when 1500 trees were planted with the help of more than 200 members of the community. A grant of £5000 from Essex County Council helped us to achieve this.

The Council has also made grants totalling £3,500 to three community groups—The Castle Point Sports Club for the Disabled, The Castle Point Sports Club and Coastwatch. These groups, which are run by volunteers help a great many people in the local area.

At the Town Meeting held on 22nd May, which was attended by about 120 people, I outlined the Council's aspirations for the future. These included tackling dog fouling in partnership with the Borough Council, improving festive lighting, improvements to Canvey Lake, installation of a further phase of equipment at the Skateboard park, more bus shelters and more seating, improvements to the seaside gardens, greater partnership working with other authorities, investigating a farmers market on the Island and more community forums to enable more community involvement. I hope that by the time I make my report next year the improvements the Council aims to achieve will already be evident.

The Council is very pleased to be working closely with the Thames Ambulance Service in an initiative to deliver basic first aid training to Year 7 schoolchildren who attend the Island's schools. Initially a pilot scheme will be run with 180 children from Castle View School in July.

There are eleven town councillors representing all wards on the Island and their contact details are included at the back of this report. Please contact them if you wish to raise a local issue or contact the Council Office directly.

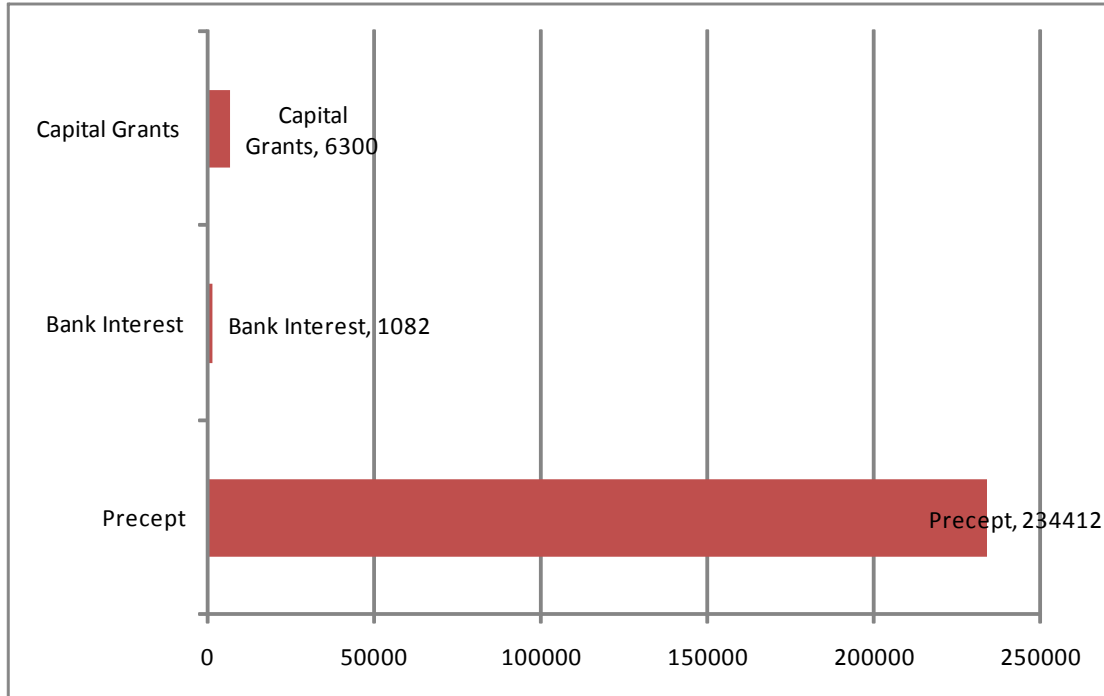
I would like to end my report by stating that the Town Council is dedicated to improving Canvey Island for the community.

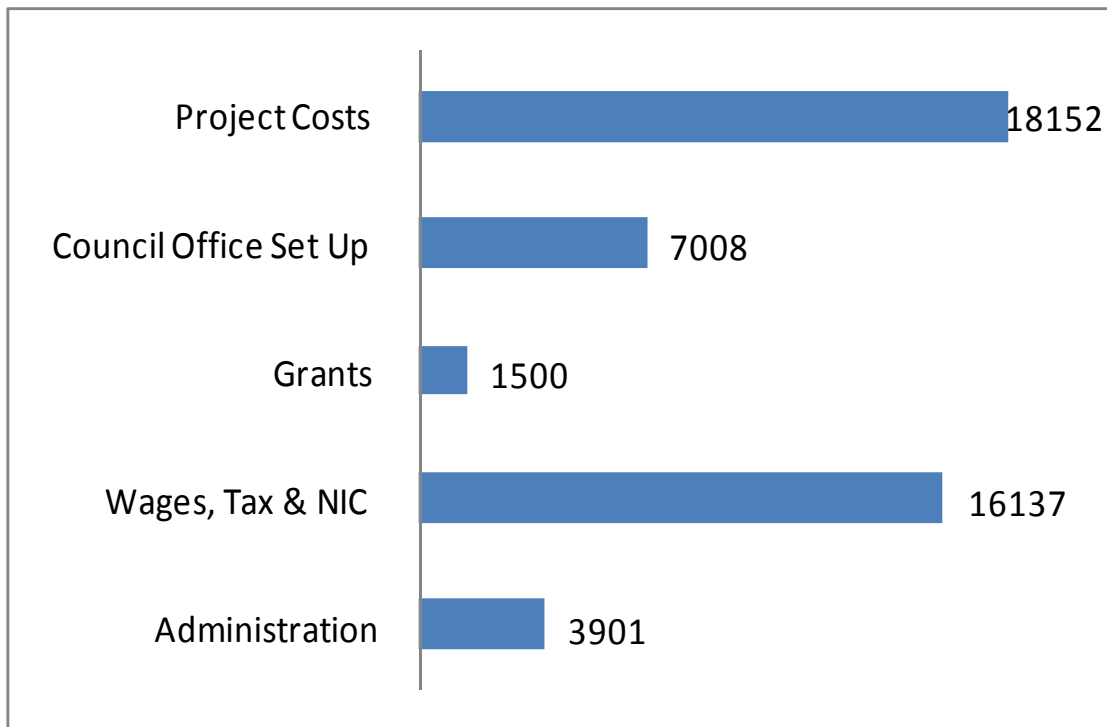
# COUNCIL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE 2007-2008

## INCOME (£s)



The Council had an income totalling £241,793 in 2007-2008. The precept represented 97% of this income. This sum is collected from the Canvey Island residents through their Council Tax. In 2007–2008 a Band D tax payer paid the sum of £20.69 per annum for the services provided by the Town Council over and above those provided by other authorities.

## EXPENDITURE (£S)



The Council's total expenditure in 2007-2008 was £46,698. At 31st March 2008, the Council's accounts showed a cash in hand sum of £195,095. A proportion of this sum has been allocated to projects to take place in the 2008-2009 year. The remainder will be used to offset future precept increases and to ensure that a contingency sum is held for long term Council security in line with Audit recommendations.

## THE COUNCIL AND ITS COMMITTEE SYSTEM

At its Annual Council Meeting in May the Council resolved to establish a system for carrying out its business through committees. The Council has formed four committees: Community Relations, Environment and Open Spaces, Planning and Policy and Finance. These committees will meet in turn at fortnightly intervals throughout the Council year to assist in progressing the Council's business.

As the Council has no formal meeting venue, if you wish to attend a meeting please check with the Council Office to find out where the meeting will be taking place. Agendas are displayed in the Council Office window, in Canvey Library and sometimes in the Borough Council's notice boards.

All Planning Committee meetings will start at 7.00pm.

All other Committee meetings and Council meetings will start at 7.30pm. All scheduled meetings take place on a Monday unless otherwise stated.
