Crime reduction advice

We are working hard to reduce crime on Canvey, by using targeted patrols. As ever we rely on help from the local community. Please be vigilant and report suspicious activity to us. Cars or homes that are left insecure by their owners are most likely to be broken into. Please help us to reduce crime by locking your cars and homes and removing valuables from view. Anti-social behaviour

We are committed dealing with anti-social behaviour on the Island working in partnership with the local council and other agencies. If you have any issues please let us know. A large proportion of issues we are called about involve youth nuisance. I would ask that all parents and guardians of children ensure that they are aware of the whereabouts of their child and who they are with.

Rest assured that if young people are found committing anti-social behaviour they will be taken home and their parents will be informed. We will also inform their school and other agencies to help us tackle the issue that are happening.

We also get a lot of calls about vehicles being driving in an anti-social manner, if we find them being driven off road or in an anti-social manner the driver will receive a warning. If they are seen again in similar circumstances they will have their vehicle seized and crushed. There are sites that can be used for off driving, the nearest being Watlington Road in Benfleet.

During the past few months we have enjoyed helping out with several community events including The Castle Point Show, the firework events run by the council, Parades and Memorial services run by The Royal British Legion and the Christmas events run by the council and local school initiatives. None of this would be possible without the assistance that we receive from the Special Constabulary working in Canvey.
